3 Overall Activity and Achievements

- The reporting of the third-party interim evaluation results to the CAPWR steering committee, each Task Force, and Industry, Academia, and Government Diversity Promotion Conference member organizations and a subsequent discussion on areas requiring improvement were undertaken. The main points of improvement are as follows:
- The symposium and seminars about CAPWR were organized and pamphlet distribution methods were enhanced, so that more female researchers and students will be actively participating in various activities by understanding the CAPWR purposes and meanings.
- Furthermore, in order to enhance the distribution of information about CAPWR within and outside of university, the contents and structure of the CAPWR's website were reviewed and reconstructed for easier understanding, with regular updates being continuously posted.
- In response to a request to increase the information exchange opportunities amongst Industry, Academia, and Government Diversity Promotion Conference members, a discussion was conducted with member organizations for the establishment of an information exchange time, before and after regular meetings.
- The third-party evaluation results were presented at the CAPWR interim general symposium, and these results have also been published on the CAPWR website.
- Reviews on methods, targets, and procedures of third-party evaluation were undertaken.
